- ❖ It was also noted that, in response to concerns that the Exec is cliquey, that there needs to be a dichotomy between Exec roles and personal.
- ❖ Exec members should also make clear the difference between personal and official events and should take care to communicate with the correct people in appropriate ways.

c. Use of Cambridge images on an extreme Christian website

- ❖ A website (with no connection to Cambridge) using images of the university to promote an extreme Christian group in America has been brought to Olly's attention.
